Jones Point Park:

Teresa Miller, from Yates Garden Civic Association, will provide an update on the Jones Point Park plan which includes a proposal to cut down four acres of wooded area for two soccer fields. (Why is it that the only solution the city seems to find for additional recreational areas is at the cost of open space?)

Freedmen's Cemetery:

Lillie Finklea of the Friends of Freedmen's Cemetery will discuss the proposal to restore the Freedmen's Cemetery (1001 South Washington Street) as part of the mitigation of impacts from the construction of a new Woodrow Wilson Bridge.

Slaters Lane One Way Paired Loop:

City Council is about to make its decision on whether or not to implement the 'one way paired loop' on Slaters Lane.

Please let them know - call, write, e-mail - that you do not want this change to Slaters Lane.
