Washington Street (Zoning) Standards; elimination of GW Pkwy interchange at Dangerfield Is.; Old Colony, massive office renewal refocused to residential development.; Mason Hall parking; Powhatan Traffic Calming - Phase 1 done, planing for Phase II; Planning for Improved Pedestrian access to the Braddock Metro from our neighborhood; Redevelopment of the Braddock metro area; Improved Madison Homes on Portner and Bernard Roads; Open Space -With one of the lowest public open space ratios in the City. We have developed a comprehensive plan to address this issue.
