

Beata Vergine Maria del Carmine



Beata Vergine Maria del Carmine is a 20th century convent church in Rome in the Prati district, in via Sforza Pallavicini.

The church was built in neo-Renaissance style in 1925 by architect Edmond Saint Just for the Carmelites of the annexed monastery and the International Center of St. Albert (CISA). The simple façade, hidden by a tree in front, shows the inscription: Mater decor Carmeli. The interior has three naves. On the high altar there is a stained glass window with the Virgin of Mount Carmel while holding the scapular to San Simone.
