



custom is maintained by the Holy Father on Good Friday evening. A Way of the Cross by St Leonard is passed on the way to the church. A painted Madonna and a crucifix which he used on his missions are preserved here, respectively to the right and left of the sanctuary. St Leonard died here in 1751, and you may visit the rooms he occupied.

**Special notes:**

Visiting the church is a nice opportunity to see an Italian friary, and a welcome escape from the crowds in the Forum. It's in the archaeological area of the Palatine hill, and there is an entrance fee.

Buried in the tomb he had built for himself

Buried next to the tomb of his uncle Cardinal Valenti Gonzaga

Antonio Maria Cardinal FROSINI, (1751-1834)

Buried next to the urn containing the ashes of St. Leonardo di Porto Maurizio
