

San Salvatore in Onda



San Salvatore in Onda is dedicated to Our Saviour.

History:

Church of ancient origin, dating from the end of the 11th century or the beginning of the 12th is mentioned for the first time in a Bull of Pope Honorius II of 1127 , which, among the Roman priests, a *priest* appointed *Crescentius Salvatoris in Onda* (the priest Crescenzo Salvatore in Onda). This name comes from the many floods of the Tiber in the past that affected the area and the church.

In 1445 the church and the adjoining convent were granted by Pope Eugenius IV to the Friars Minor Conventual , and the 14 August 1844 Gregory XVI granted all at Vincent Pallotti for the religious community he founded.

Following this transfer, the church, which had already undergone a major restoration in the 18th century with the rise of the floor, underwent further renovations by architect [Luca Carimini](#), which brought to light the columns and capitals of primitive structure.

Exterior:

Adjacent to the church is a monastery that has housed the Hermits of St Paul, Augustinians and the Conventual Friars.

Interior:

The church has three naves divided by 12 columns. At the center of the apse there is the *Madonna with Child* by [Cesare Mariani](#) (1878)

Under the main altar is a crystal burial urn containing the mortal remains of St. Vincent Pallotti.

In a side altar there is the *Virgo Potens*, image donated by the venerable Elizabeth Sanna (died 1857 and buried in the church).

Under the chancel is a crypt of medieval origins, part of the primitive church. It is rectangular and three small naves divided by columns with Roman vaults, a large Corinthian capital serves as an altar
